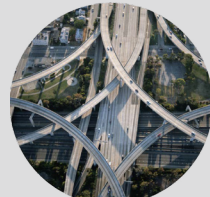

ECFA is America’s premier accreditation agency dedicated to helping Christian ministries earn the public’s trust through adherence to Seven Standards of Responsible Stewardship. In order to be approved by ECFA, nonprofits, ministries, educational institutions, and churches must demonstrate that they meet high standards of board governance, financial transparency, integrity in fundraising, and proper use of charity resources.

Accreditation and acceptance as member of ECFA is very important achievement for Worldharvest. It means that we have passed a rigorous test of how we handle the funds entrusted to us by donors and foundations. At Worldharvest, not only we strive to ensure that we have full compliance with the law, we also make sure we adhere to the highest ethical ministry standards. We make sure that all donation moneys are not only accounted for, but always used for the exact intent of the donor. An independent, public audit is conducted annually.

LOVE IS A VERB CAMPAIGN

This campaign, we aim to get at least 100 children sponsored so they can afford a proper education and executed in partnership with all major IFGF churches in America and Canada. All newly sponsored children received a care package with toys, school supplies, a backpack, and other essential stationeries. Children sponsorship is the backbone of our organization and is perhaps our most fundamental program. We believe these children are the next leaders and lawmakers of their nations, and that by reaching out to these children, we can change the trajectory of an entire nation.

SAVING LIVES & GIVING HOPE THROUGH RELIEF AND HUMANITARIAN PROJECTS

Natural Disasters strike suddenly, leaving death and destruction in their path. World Harvest Disaster Relief Teams respond with Emergency Medical Assistance, food, clothing, Family Relief Packages and counseling. Recovery, development and empowerment programs provide long-term assistance to affected communities, restoring hope to disaster victims.

On Saturday, April 16th at 7 PM, Ecuador experienced a record shattering, 7.8 magnitude earthquake. This earthquake killed over 650 people and injured 12,000 others. A few days after the earthquake, World Harvest dispatched a Disaster Relief Response Team to Ecuador to distribute food, water, antibiotics, and other necessities to the 12,000 earthquake victims. As soon as the response team touched ground, they immediately got to work. They began by cooking hot meals at 9 PM and continued to serve the hungry until midnight. This process has been repeated daily since the team had been dispatched. Each day and night, thousands of victims lined up for food, water, and medical treatment.

CORPORATIONS SHOW SUPPORT FOR WORLD HARVEST AT ANNUAL GALA LUNCHEON

Business leaders, professionals, and humanitarians unite to raise funds for charity that supports impoverished communities. A collection of prominent individuals and companies gathered at the Quiet Cannon Event Center in Montebello to celebrate corporate social responsibility while supporting World Harvest. A member of the Indonesian Consulate was in attendance and gave a speech in support of the organization's efforts. Some of the corporate sponsors in attendance included Jane Wibowo, CEO of First Way Insurance and Yosua Christanto, owner of Usana.

The main highlight of the event was a panel discussion where local business leaders shared their secrets of business and leadership success accentuating the value of corporate social responsibility and their partnerships with World Harvest. The panel comprised LA's distinguished business owners including: Jemmy Pranyoto, CEO of Golden Nest Inc., Rudy Kusuma, CEO of RE/MAX Titanium, Anthony Kartawinata, CEO of Wira Corp., and Bruce Lie, CEO of Hippocampe USA, and Randy Brewer of Brewer Direct.

The 2016 Good Samaritan award was given to Bruce Lie, to recognize him as an invaluable partner to World Harvest who has supported the organization and its causes both professionally and personally with compassion for strangers and charitable support for over 16 years. Bruce sponsors 12 children in Africa and Indonesia in their educational pursuits and is an ambassador for World Harvest in Los Angeles.

Every person in attendance also supported a child to go to school for one month, while each table supported a child's schooling for an entire year. Thus, eleven more children were sponsored for an entire year as a result of the gala. Guests were able to take home insights on how to grow their businesses and their professional prowess as well as the satisfaction of partaking in a global mission to alleviate poverty.

HARVEST COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

WORKING WITH DKI JAKARTA TO EMPOWER MUARA BARU COMMUNITY

World Harvest was appointed by DKI Jakarta Government to be a Housing Project Coordinator in Muara Baru North Jakarta. In 2016, we have been working with Gema Kasih Yobel for more than 1 year to provide weekly Medical Care in this community. The medical care program includes doctor treatment, blood and cholesterol test, medicines and vitamins.

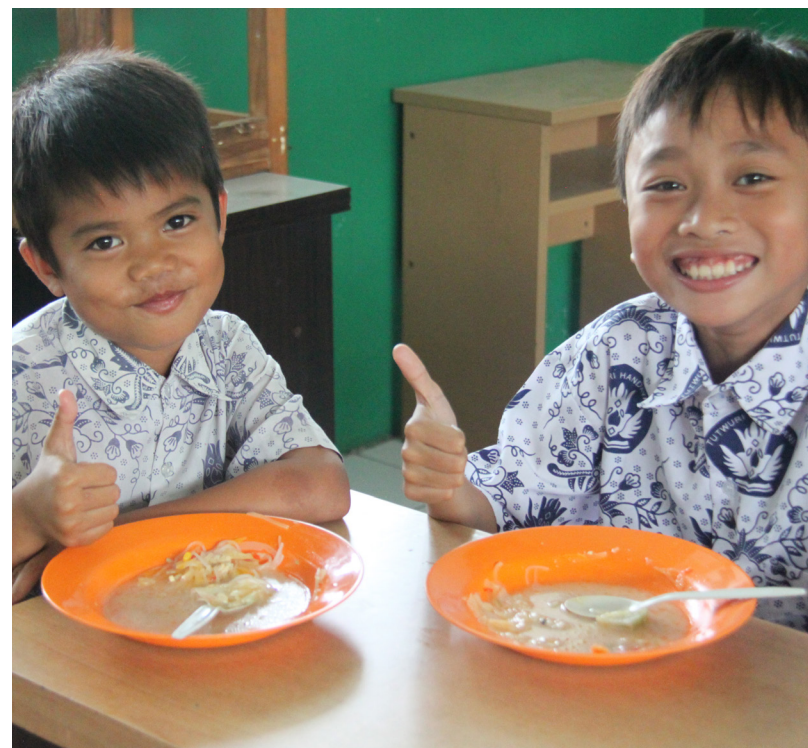
Since July 2016, World Harvest works together with Pansophia Foundation to open Playgroup and Kindergarten for children at Housing Project Muara Baru. Total current student: 47 students (16 Playgroup, 31 Kindergarten). Besides playing and learning, the school provide milk for all students on daily basis, healthy food on Tuesday and Thursday, vitamins on Monday & Wednesday.

EAT BETTER, FEEL BETTER - DAILY HEALTHY FOOD FOR THE CHILDREN

2016 marks our fourth year working with Hand of Hope in preparing nutritional meals for our 650 children in 6 communities on a daily basis, Monday till Friday.

We are committed to build communities through a holistic approach, giving scholarships, nutritious food supplements, medical treatment and job creation programs at our targeted community in Jakarta, Tangerang and Bekasi area. About 5,340 people received free medical treatment at our various communities.



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AGENT

In 2000, Dalhing Hutasoit joined World Harvest as Community Development Agent in Kampung Sawah, a community that is known for its high unemployment rate in North Jakarta area. Our target in this area is to secure the future for younger generation to get proper education and health care regardless their economic situation. For the last 17 years, he has been working passionately to make an impact in this community. Together with our support, Mr. Hutasoit is able to give the children opportunity to receive good education, daily healthy food and free medical care.

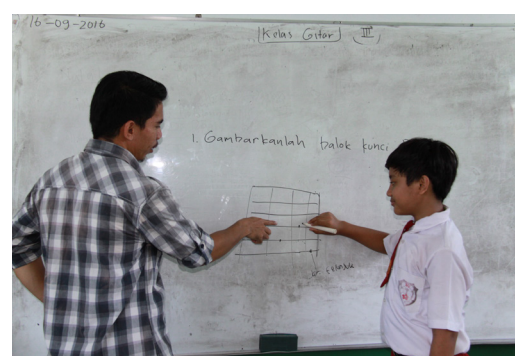

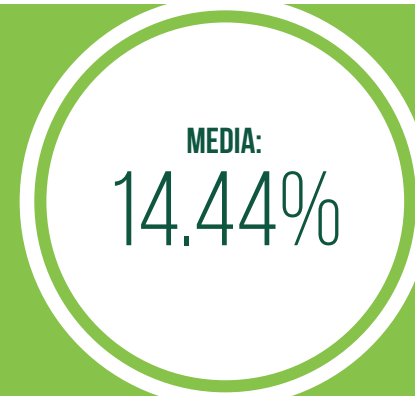
