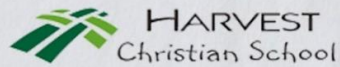

At World Harvest, we believe that there is never an act of kindness that is ever wasted. Every seed of generosity leaves a large impact for the communities we are consistently trying to help nurture and grow. When we invest in children, families, and communities, we are actively creating a more equal and better tomorrow. When we create opportunities for those who struggle to attain access due to socioeconomic or infrastructure related barriers, we give people the chance to create the future that they dream of. Year over year, we are committed to partner with communities in order to empower individuals to exercise freedom over their own destinies and those who come after them.

With your partnership, in 2020, we launched a number of grassroots initiatives to help alleviate the chronically difficult conditions offset by COVID-19 through **COMMUNITY PILLAR**. This year, we provided aid and assistance during the pandemic season to more than 60,000 people around Indonesia in 28 areas, 52 hospitals, and 8 religious centers throughout Java, Sulawesi, Papua and other remote areas. We were also able to adopt 26 communities in Indonesia, providing these communities with formal, integrated education for over 1000 children.

Aside from our community work, we also continued to bring impact through **EDUCATION PILLAR**. A number of our students from our **Wahana Harapan Schools** won various competitions in the Science and Mathematics Olympiad at the school district level in Tangerang. Also, our very own **Harvest Christian School** attained an A grade from the National Accreditation Board, and we are planning to expand the impact of HCS by expanding our offerings to reach senior high level. Furthermore, **Harvest International Theological Seminary**, as one of the leading Theological Schools in the country, has continually committed to equip & empower students not only with biblical knowledge but also with the skill & abilities to contribute to the society. Many of our grads are off to an incredible career journey, including one of whom became a Vice Chancellor in one of the leading universities in West Java. Finally, in November 2020, **STMIK Harvest**, our technopreneur campus, was granted the official extension license by the Education Department until 2025.

Finally, last but not least, from **MEDIA PILLAR** included our recent expansion in partnership with various digital platforms to provide the best Christian programs in the country & beyond. Since few years ago, we work together with MyRepublic, TransVision, Usee TV and Vidio, and has successfully broadcasted to approximately over 160 million potential viewers all over the world.

Without your continuous support, we would not be able to land the impact that we created this year. 2020 showed us that even in the hardest of times, we are capable of coming together to make the world a better and safer place for the marginalized, underserved and underrepresented.

I really appreciated your partnership and generosity and let's continue to create a **BETTER TOMORROW together**.

Greetings from the Vice Chairman

To say that 2020 was a year like no other would be an understatement. Who could have thought that the world would be brought to its knees by something so small? Yet in the midst of this we saw God move and even open up a new window of opportunities.

Take Mumbai for Instance. A city of 24 million people with more than half living in the slums. When the city was put under lockdown., these slum day laborers almost immediately went hungry. In the months that ensued, more died of starvation and suicides because of it than from covid itself,

That is when we saw the miracle of Sack Farming. Our team in Los Angeles spent the Summer researching and learning to plant food in sacks. We taught 150 slum dwelling families in Mumbai how to improve their own food security.

The program was very successful, and this year we replicate it in 7 other areas in India, Pakistan, Kenya, Sierra Leone and Uganda. Doors are opening even in Sudan and Afghanistan.

I'm amazed how God works miracles in the midst of extremely challenging times. I pray that He is doing that in your lives as well. "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."

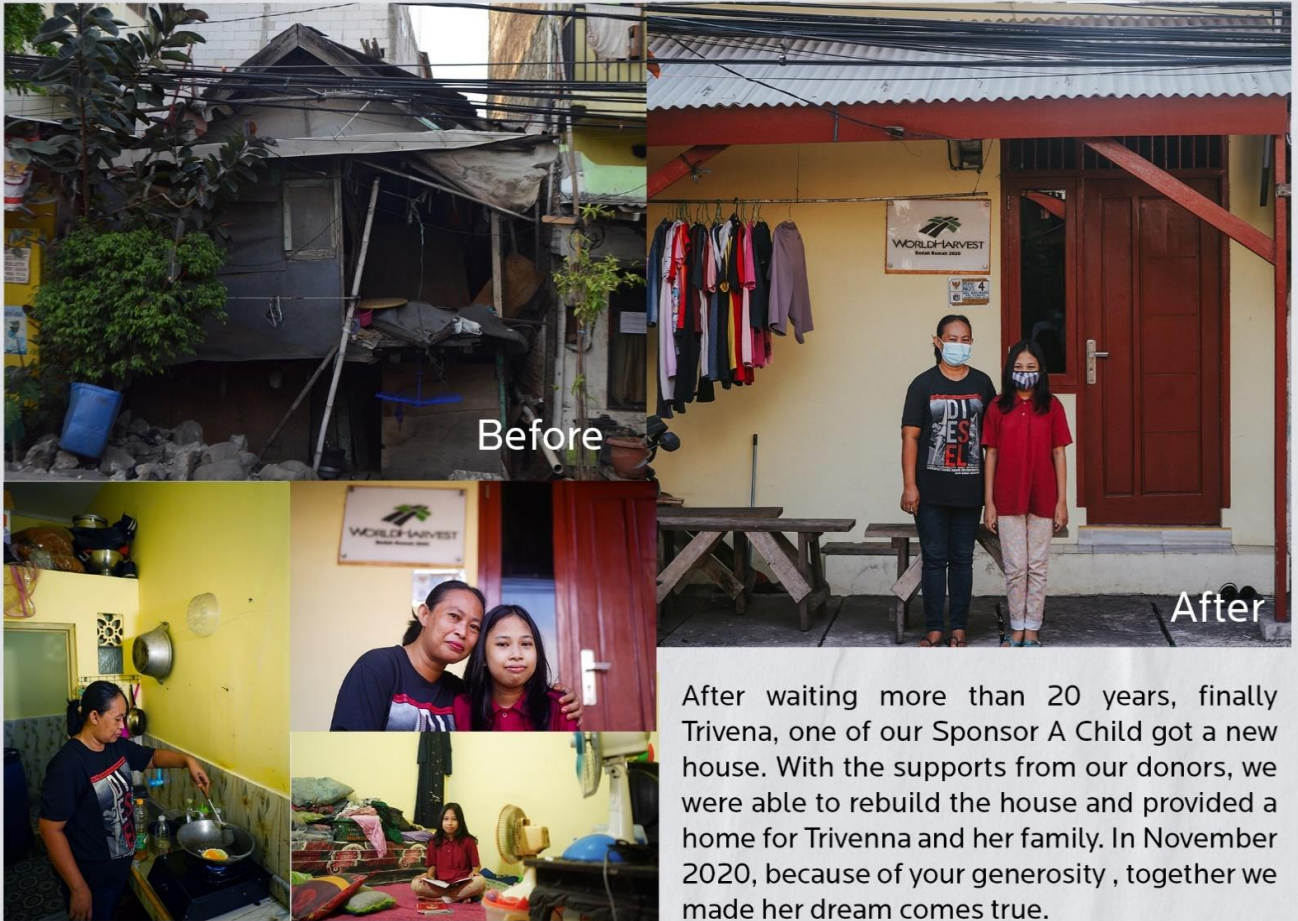
➤ HEALTH SERVICES
